GENERAL CLASS GUIDELINES

Most class sessions are 1 hour weekly, with the exception of 45 minute sessions for most elementary age students and 30 minute sessions for pre-school age classes. All art supplies are included for students within the price of the Art classes. Tuition for dance classes include classroom use of music, dance bars and mirrors – nothing more is required, with the exception of dance shoes and outfits, if students desire to be outfitted special for class. Electronic keyboards are supplied for use during keyboarding classes, but students should have their own for practicing at home. Singing classes require no special supplies or instruments. All other music classes do not provide instruments, and it is the responsibility of each student to bring their own to class and for practice at home.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Classes are grouped by student age as a general guideline, but students may be relocated if ability levels differ from the majority of class members. For students needing additional support due to illness or handicap, a parent or guardian may be asked to assist with their instructional activities, and will be determined on an individual basis. Guardians should plan on being present in any case. Each teacher reserves the right to refuse service to any student who is disruptive, disrespectful, and chronically tardy/absent.
